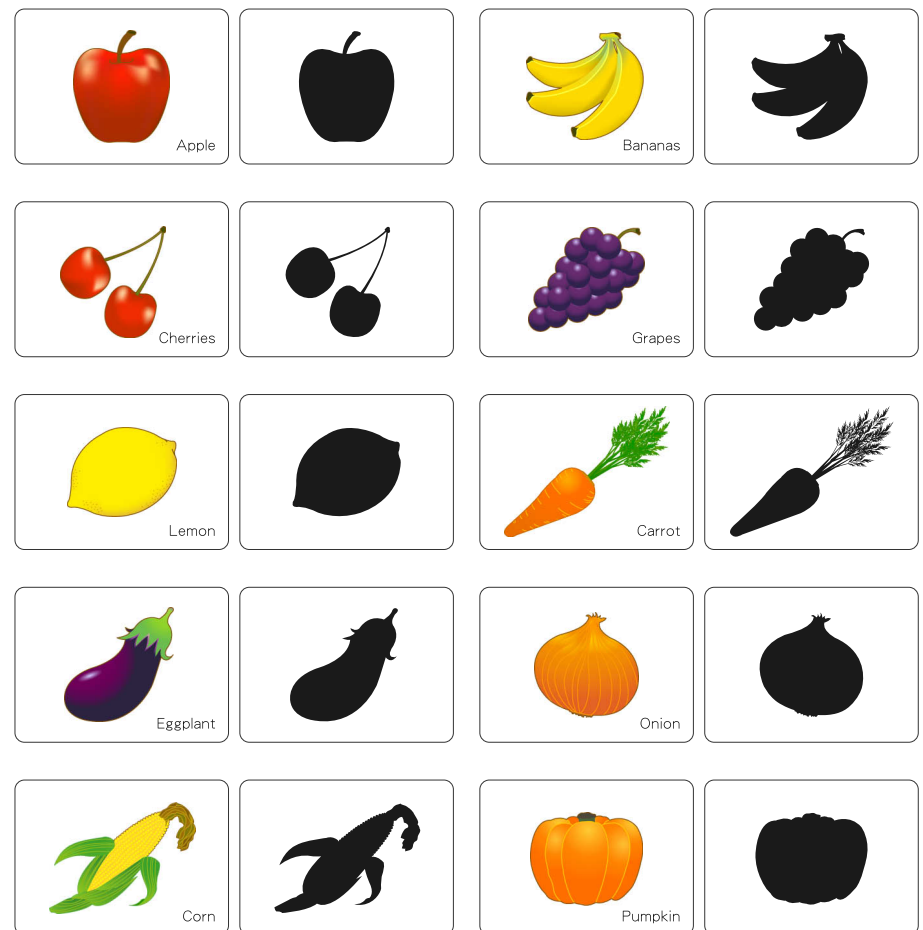




HOW TO PLAY

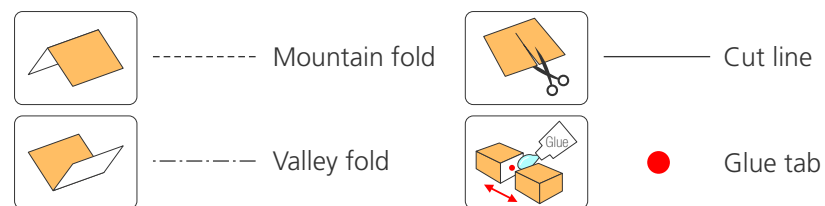


HOW TO MAKE

■ Pattern: 7 sheets ■ Assembly Instructions: 2 sheets ■ Number of Parts: 13

You will need: Scissors, glue, ruler, a used ball-point pen

Assembly Tip: Trace along the folds with a ruler and a used pen (no ink) to get a sharper, easier fold.




Caution: This craft requires the use of glue, scissors, and other tools which may be dangerous to young children. Please keep them out of reach of children while you work. The finished craft may have sharp corners, so please keep a close eye on children when they play with it.
